

ABSENTEE VOTING

BRANDYWINE SCHOOL DISTRICT

SCHOOL BOARD MEMBER ELECTION

Tuesday, May 12, 2009

To vote in a school district election you must be a citizen of the United States and Delaware, a resident of the school district and 18 years of age or older. You do not have to be a registered voter. If you are eligible to vote, but unable to go to the polls on Election Day for a reason as defined by law, you may vote by Absentee Ballot, either by mail or in person.

To vote by mail: Call 577-3464 to request that an *Affidavit for Absentee Ballot* be mailed to you. A copy of the *Affidavit* may be downloaded from the Department's website at <http://electionsncc.delaware.gov>. We must receive your properly completed *Affidavit* prior to Noon on Friday, May 8, 2009. The Department of Elections for New Castle County will mail an Absentee Ballot to you as soon as it is available.

To vote in person: Bring identification to the Department of Elections for New Castle County, Carvel State Office Building, 4th Floor, 820 North French Street, Wilmington, DE 19801 on normal business days between 8:30 a.m. and 4 p.m. through Friday, May 8, 2009 and until Noon on Monday, May 11, 2009.

NOTE: You must present a valid government issued photo ID to be admitted to the Carvel State Office Building.

In order to be counted, Absentee Ballots must be returned to the offices of the Department of Elections for New Castle County, Carvel State Office Building, 4th Floor, 820 North French Street, Wilmington, DE 19801 no later than 8 p.m. on Tuesday, May 12, 2009. Absentee Ballots will not be accepted at any polling place.
