

INSTRUCTIONS

1. There are three (3) questions on the ballot.
2. Make ALL of your selections BEFORE pushing the green VOTE button located below the lower right corner of the ballot.
3. Press the "X" to the right of your choice to select it. Once you press the "X", you will see a red light at the upper left corner of that "X". This indicates your choice.
4. If you wish to change your choice, press the "X" again and the light will go out. Then, press the "X" to the right of your choice to make a new selection.
5. Make sure that a red light is illuminated at the upper left corner of the "X" for your choices BEFORE pushing the green VOTE button to cast your ballot.

Vote for or against the bond issue in Section I by pressing the "X" in the box next to your choice. In Section II, vote for Option A or B by pressing the "X" in the box next to the option you prefer. In Section III, vote for or against the additional taxes for School Purposes by pressing the "X" in the box next to the option you prefer.
