



School Board Elections

Department of Elections for New Castle County

- Complaint about a candidate's residency
 - Insufficient evidence to determine that he did not live where he says he lives.
- Elections went well.
 - Very few issues. See the separate problem log.
 - Canvassed results same as the Election Night unofficial results.
- Recommend that the Board certify the School Board results.

Financial highlights

Department of Elections for New Castle County

- On track
- Continue to watch energy costs
 - May have to transfer funds to cover shortfall
 - So far this FY's expenditures about \$10,065 less than last FY
- Transferring \$6,000 of 2010 School Election money to DOE for Kent County because they are running short.


