


 - In-person: 9



State Legislation

Department of Elections for New Castle County

- Title 15 – passed House, Senate hearing tomorrow
 - List maintenance
 - Polling Place mandate
 - Extends electronic transmittal and return to disabled voters
- Constitutional Amendment – was introduced in June
- Title 15 cleanup – to be introduced
 - Modifies some dates related to the Presidential Primary
 - Clarifies voter assistance
 - Authorizes scanning of absentee ballots beginning the Friday before an election
 - Revises the machine/registered voter requirement
 - Eliminates some obsolete language






