




- Title 15 – passed House, waiting Senate action
- Constitutional Amendment – waiting action
- Title 15 cleanup – to be introduced
 - Modifies some dates related to the Presidential Primary
 - Clarifies voter assistance
 - Authorizes scanning of absentee ballots beginning the Friday before an election
 - Revises the machine/registered voter requirement
 - Eliminates some obsolete language
