



Department of Elections for New Castle County

- Will assign additional machines and Election Officers at some polling places for future referendums in both Appoquinimink and Colonial
 - There were 2 complaints that we had too many Polling Places in Appoquinimink, the folks thought that 6 or 7 would be enough, turnout more than justified the number of polling places
- Canvassed results the same as reported following the referendums
- Recommend that the Board certify the results of both referendums
