


Appoquinimink Referendum

Department of Elections for New Castle County

- Recommend the Board certify the results
- No significant problems
 - Sent strong reminder to Poll Workers reminding them not to discuss the referendum
 - A person voted twice at Middletown HS – Poll Worker error
 - Report of Poll Workers being “snippy” when parents brought young children to Waters Middle School – Inspector strongly denied the allegation, found that there were some older folks outside the entrance who may have been the cause of the complaint
 - Complaints about inadequate parking at Old State Elementary School



School Board Elections

Department of Elections for New Castle County

- Recommend the Board certify the results
- No significant problems
 - Complaint from Brandywine High School that a machine wasn't working. The technician could not find a problem. Most likely a Poll Worker wasn't properly activating the machine.
 - A person voted twice at Meredith Middle School. Poll Worker problem.
 - Some pens not working. Will replace as needed before the Colonial Referendum and 2014 School Board Election. Will replace entire stock before 2014 Primary Election.
 - Location of several voting locations in Christina buildings changed at last-minute (these things don't happen?)



Facilities, equipment, and other initiatives

Department of Elections for New Castle County

- Begun process to increase space available for voter services in the warehouse lobby
 - Space will support operations if Carvel Building is inaccessible
 - Submitted to OMB for final review/approval
- Statewide voter portal being tested and refined
 - Development is continuing. May roll-out in 60 days.
 - Security assessment will be done
 - User group review to fine-tune

 - Delayed process until mid-June due to the election schedule. Would expect to complete process by early 2014.
