Anyone wishing to be considered as a candidate for the position of Mayor or Councilperson must file as a candidate for election on forms provided by the Town by no later than 7:00PM on Monday, February 07, 2011.

Qualifications of candidates for the offices of Mayor and Council

Any qualified voter of the Town of Elsmere who is, or will be, at least twenty-one years of age on, or before, April 30, 2011, has not been convicted of a felony and who has, or will have, been a qualified elector of the Town of Elsmere for at least one year prior to April 30, 2011, is eligible to file as a candidate for the office of Mayor or Councilperson; provided that any person elected to the office of Council must, at the time of his or her election, reside in the district from which elected.

A filing fee of \$36.00 for the office of Mayor and \$30.00 for the office of Councilperson must be paid at the time of registration.

The normal operating hours of the Town Hall are 8:00AM to 4:00PM Monday through Friday except holidays and will be open on February 07, 2011 until 7:00PM.
