NOTICE – Absentee Ballot

THE TOWN CHARTER PROVIDES THAT ANY QUALIFIED VOTER MAY VOTE BY ABSENTEE BALLOT.

In order to vote by absentee ballot:

A qualified voter must complete an Application for Absentee Ballot and return it to the Town Office or to the Chair of the Election Board no later than 12 noon on Thursday, March 31, 2016. Applications may be returned in person or by mail. The mailing address for the Town Office is P.O. Box 111, Odessa, DE 19730.

The Absentee Ballot will be sent via U.S. Mail to the applicant. In order for Absentee Ballots to count in the election, they must be received by the Odessa Board of Elections by the close of the polls, 8:00 p.m., Monday April 4, 2016.

Full instructions for filling out and returning the application are on the application form, and instructions for casting the vote are enclosed with the absentee ballot. For convenience, anyone may pick up and deliver the application to any voter, and anyone may deliver the completed application to the Town Office. The BALLOT may only be delivered to the voter by U.S. First Class Mail and returned by U.S. First Class Mail.
