

ABSENTEE VOTING - PUBLIC SCHOOL ELECTIONS

To vote in a Public School Election, you must be a U.S. citizen, a resident of the school district and 18 years of age or older. You do not have to be a registered voter. If you are eligible to vote but unable to go to the polls on Election Day for a reason as defined by law, you may vote by Absentee Ballot.

The Department of Elections for New Castle County is now accepting requests for Absentee Ballots for the May 8, 2007 Public School Board Member Elections in the Appoquinimink and Brandywine School Districts. Call 577-3464 and ask that an *Affidavit for Absentee Ballot* be mailed to you. You may download a copy of the *Affidavit* from the Department's website at <http://electionsncc.delaware.gov>. Upon receipt of a properly completed *Affidavit*, we will mail a ballot. We must receive your request prior to Noon on Friday, May 4, 2007.

If you prefer, you may vote in person at the office of the Department of Elections for New Castle County from 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Monday through Friday and until Noon on Monday, May 7, 2007. The Department will be closed Friday, April 6, 2007. NOTE: You must present a valid government issued photo ID to be admitted to the Carvel State Office Building.

In order to be counted, Absentee Ballots must be returned to the office of the Department of Elections for New Castle County, Carvel State Office Building, 4th Floor, 820 N. French Street, Wilmington DE 19801 no later than 8 p.m. on Tuesday, May 8, 2007. Absentee ballots will not be accepted at any polling place.
