## **BRANDYWINE SCHOOL BOARD CANDIDATE WITHDRAWS**

**“EARLIER THIS MORNING, DONALD W. SOLES, JR. WITHDREW AS A CANDIDATE FOR THE BRANDYWINE SCHOOL BOARD IN TUESDAY’S ELECTION” SAID ELAINE MANLOVE, ADMINISTRATIVE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ELECTIONS FOR NEW CASTLE COUNTY.**

“The Department will attempt to inform people who have voted by absentee ballot of the withdrawal, and any person who has already voted by absentee ballot and wants to revote must come to the Department’s office at 820 N French Street, Suite 400 in Wilmington no later than Noon on Monday, May 7<sup>th</sup>.

“Since the certified and sealed voting machines are in the process of being delivered to the polling places, the Department cannot replace the voting machine ballots. Department staff shall place pasters over Mr. Soles’ name on the voting machine ballots and the Sample Ballots on Tuesday, May 8<sup>th</sup>.” “Poll workers who have not attended a training class yet will be notified of this change during class, and the rest will be informed before the polls open at 10 a.m. on Tuesday.”

Title XIV, Section 1075 of the Delaware Code states that any votes cast for a person who has withdrawn as a candidate shall be considered null and void and shall not be tallied, canvassed or reported.
