“THE DEPARTMENT OF ELECTIONS FOR NEW CASTLE COUNTY WILL CONDUCT A TEST OF THE ABSENTEE BALLOT TABULATION SYSTEM ON WEDNESDAY, JANUARY 30. THE PUBLIC IS INVITED TO OBSERVE THIS EVENT,” ACCORDING TO MR. ANTHONY ALBENCE, THE DEPARTMENT’S ADMINISTRATIVE DIRECTOR.

“The Department of Elections for New Castle County will provide the public an opportunity to learn about and observe testing of the absentee voting system that the State of Delaware uses to accurately count absentee votes” according to Mr. Albence.

“The public test of the absentee ballot tabulation system for the February 5, 2008 Presidential Primary Election will be conducted at 1 p.m. on Wednesday, January 30, 2008, in the Department’s Offices, 4th Floor, Carvel State Office Building. The public is invited to observe and participate in the test,” according to Mr. Albence.

“The public is also invited to observe the process of preparing and counting the absentee ballots. Preparation will begin in our office on February 2, 2008 at 1 p.m. on the 4th floor of the Carvel State Office Building located at 820 N French Street in Wilmington. The tabulation will begin at 9 a.m. on February 5 and the public may observe this process,” according to Mr. Albence.
