“THE DEADLINE TO REGISTER TO VOTE IN THE UPCOMING JANUARY 13, 2011 SPECIAL ELECTION, TO FILL THE VACANT PRESIDENT OF NEW CASTLE COUNTY COUNCIL SEAT, IS APPROACHING,” ACCORDING TO ANTHONY ALBENCE, THE DEPARTMENT’S DIRECTOR.

“To participate in this election, residents of New Castle County must be registered voters by January 3, 2011. You can use the voter registration wizard at <https://registertovote.elections.delaware.gov> to fill out and print an application. Applications completed before midnight on January 3, 2011 will be honored. Or, you can visit our office in the Carvel State Office Building, 820 N French Street, Wilmington from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday. Make sure you bring identification with your physical address, not a Post Office Box number.”

“Also, we will have absentee ballots available shortly. Anyone needing a ballot may call the Department at 577-3464 to have an affidavit mailed to them. The affidavit is available at <http://electionsncc.delaware.gov>. Once ballots are printed, you may come to the Carvel Building Monday – Friday from 8:30 a.m. – 4 p.m. until January 11, 2011. The Department is closed on Friday December 24 and Friday December 31. In office absentee voting ends at Noon on Wednesday, January 12, and voted ballots must be in our office by 8 p.m. on January 13 in order to be counted,” concluded Mr. Albence.
